Rationale for SDG Linkage

Linked to SDG 4 by delivering hands-on coding, mentorship, and problem-solving for first-year tech students, building practical skills and lifelong learning.

Supported SDG 9 through 48-hour prototype development and expert judging, fostering tech innovation and teamwork for resilient systems

Objectives of the Activity

The activity aimed to encourage innovation and hands-on learning at DBUU. It focused on developing problem-solving skills through real-world challenges, providing exposure to software development and teamwork, and facilitating mentorship and networking with Team Devtods. Creative solutions receive recognition through prizes and certifications.

Description of the Activity

Developathon was a 48-hour hackathon in which participants engaged in team-based prototype development, including introduction sessions, problem statement brainstorming, coding,

mentorship, evaluation rounds by faculty and experts, and final presentations. Highlights include non-stop coding, innovative tech solutions, and networking opportunities.

Outcomes of the Activity

Participants gain enhanced technical and teamwork skills, certificates of participation, and cash prizes plus certificates for winners. The event fostered an engaging learning environment with professional networking and industry exposure.
