Objective of the Activity

The primary objective of the Donation Drive was to support underprivileged individuals in nearby communities by collecting essential items such as clothes, books, stationery, food packets, and hygiene products. The activity aimed to promote a sense of social responsibility, empathy, and community engagement among university students.

Description of the Activity

The university initiated a campus-wide Donation Drive to contribute to the welfare of economically weaker sections. Collection counters were established at key locations on campus, where students and staff deposited reusable clothes, winter wear, shoes, notebooks, pens, dry ration packets, and daily essentials.

A team of volunteers segregated the items into categories, ensuring quality and usability. After sorting and packaging, the donations were distributed to identified beneficiaries in nearby villages/communities.
