#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Dev Bhoomi Uttarakhand University stands tall with its holistic vision of fostering a society of lifelong learners and creating an environment of discovery, innovation, discourse and expression. An extension of the ethos and values of its parent organization "Uttarakhand Uthan Samiti" the University was established in 2021 vide notification no. XXXIV-C-3/2021-13(21)2020 dated 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2021 of Government of Uttarakhand.

The University is governed by Dev Bhoomi Uttarakhand University Act, 2021 and has since then taken steady strides under the able leadership of its office bearers and hand holding of governing and managing bodies. The University has organized twelve (12) statutory meetings till 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2022. Obligatory commitments of registering with UGC, AISHE, and Ministry of Social Welfare etc. have been undertaken.

Spread over an area of 42 acres; in lush green surroundings, the University offers a plethora of programmes in its 10 constituent schools. With total student strength of 1403, the University aspires to sore high and position itself as an excellent University.

With a keen eye on promoting impactful research, the University has created 102 Ph. D seats and its highly qualified faculty is in process of branding research flagship areas.
